

ORDINANCE NO. 130/2021OF

THE RECTOR OF THE UNIVERSITY OF SZCZECIN

of 21 June 2021.

on the appointment of coordinators of
the MOST Students and Doctoral Students Mobility Programme at the University of Szczecin

Pursuant to Article 23(2)(2) of the Act of 20 July 2018. Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Laws of 2021, item 478 as amended), it is ordered as follows:

§ 1.

mgr Ewa Czerwińska, is appointed University Coordinator of the Student and Doctoral Student Mobility Programme, hereinafter referred to as the "MOST Programme".

§ 2.

The following persons are appointed as the faculty coordinators of the MOST programme for students and doctoral students::

- 1) mgr Karolina Rachubinska - Faculty of Social Sciences;
- 2) dr Katarzyna Klapczyńska - Faculty of Physical Culture and Health;
- 3) dr Beata Florkiewicz - Faculty of Physical Culture and Health;
- 4) dr WojciechJedziniak- Faculty of Physical Culture and Health;
- 5) dr Agata Pyrzyńska- Faculty of Law and Administration;
- 6) dr Jarosław Korpys, Professor of the University of Szczecin - Faculty of Economics, Finance and Management;
- 7) dr Agnieszka Majewska, Professor of the University of Szczecin - Faculty of Economics, Finance and Management;
- 8) dr. Leszek Gracz - Faculty of Economics, Finance and Management;
- 9) dr Edyta Stępień - Faculty of Science and Life Sciences;
- 10) dr Emil Lesner - Faculty of Humanities;
- 11) dr Piotr Goniszewski - Faculty of Theology.

§ 3.

Dr hab. Paulina Niedźwiedzka-Rystwej, Professor of the University of Szczecin, is appointed as the Doctoral School Coordinator of the MOST Programme for doctoral students studying at the Doctoral School of the University of Szczecin.

§ 4.

The tasks of the Coordinators referred to in § 2 include, in particular:

- 1) agreeing and approving with students the list of courses specified in curriculum agreement, as well as agreeing and approving changes to that list;

- 2) assigning the appropriate number of ECTS credits for the MOST programme;
- 3) confirming in the student's transcript that the courses completed are equivalent to those completed at the University of Szczecin and entering grades obtained in the course completed at another university according to the grading scale provided in the University of Szczecin Study Regulations on the basis of the documents provided by the student.

§ 5.

The tasks of the Coordinator referred to in § 3 include in particular:

- 1) acceptance of the doctoral student's individual research plan at the home university;
- 2) agreeing to participate in the MOST Programme, with the prior approval of the supervisor(s);
- 3) agreeing and approving the curriculum agreement with doctoral students, as well as agreeing and approving changes to it;
- 4) completing the implementation of the curriculum agreement.

§ 6.

Performing the function of the Coordinator, referred to in § 2-3, exhausts the requirements in the periodic evaluation of teachers - parameter C (organisational duties resulting from the performance of the function at the University of Szczecin), set out in the Decision No. 195/2019 of the Rector of the University of Szczecin of 29 November 2019 on the rules of periodic evaluation of academic teachers carried out at the University of Szczecin.

§ 7.

The decision No. 2/2020 of the Rector of the University of Szczecin of 8 January 2020 on appointing coordinators for the MOST Student and Doctoral Mobility Programme at the University of Szczecin expires.

§ 8.

The decision shall enter into force on the date of its signature.
