1.	Publishing a scientific monograph or a chapter in scientific monographs published by publishing houses included in the list of publishing houses developed consistently with the regulations issued pursuant to art. 267, section 2, point 2 of the Higher Education and Science Act of 20th of July 2018 (Dz.U. 2021, item 478 as amended)	<b>50-100 points</b>
2.	Authorship or co-authorship of a scientific paper published in a scientific journal or in peer-reviewed international conference materials which were included in their final form in the year of publishing in the list of scientific journals and materials developed consistently with the regulations adopted on the basis of art. 267, section 2, point 2 of the Higher Education and Science Act of 20th of July 2018 (Dz.U. 2021, item 478 as amended)	<b>40-80 points</b>
3.	Significant contribution to a highly innovative scientific project realized by the university in which a student receives or concluded education, including participation in a research project financed within the framework of a nation-wide or international contest.	<b>30-60 points</b>
4.	Authorship and presentation of a scientific paper concerning highly innovative scientific studies during an international science conference held abroad.	<b>20-40 points</b>
5.	Receiving an individual award in a highly prestigious contest of an international reach in which students of at least five countries participated.	<b>20-40 points</b>
<b>Category - artistic achievements</b>		
1.	Individual author exhibition organized by a highly prestigious cultural institution.	<b>50-100 points</b>
2.	Authorship of musical works recorded and released by a highly prestigious record producer.	<b>50-100 points</b>
3.	Significant contribution to creation of an audio-visual work, including a film, presented during a highly prestigious review or festival with at least nation-wide reach or distributed in cinema or television.	<b>30-60 points</b>
4.	Significant contribution to creation of a theatre, opera, operetta, ballet or musical play presented during a highly prestigious review or festival with at least nation-wide reach.	<b>30-60 points</b>
5.	Receiving an individual or team award in a highly prestigious	<b>40-80 points</b>

\*\* In case of sports achievements only sports with associated Polish sports federations stipulated in the act of 25th of June of 2010 on sports (Dz.U. 2020, item 1133) and Polish sports federations for disabled persons are taken into consideration. Each type of achievement is to be documented with an appropriate certificates which must include information regarding: the applicant, the entity organizing the sports event, date, location and character of the achievement certified by a Polish sports federation or a nationwide academic sports federation.

\*\*\* Certificate of social work for the benefit of the University/Faculty and region is issued by an appropriate body within the framework of which a student operated.
